

## **Video Guidelines**

- As when doing any No Stirrup work- Use arenas that are free from distractions. Use common sense, if something doesn't seem right with you or your horse, or if your horse seems a bit fresh, wait to ride without stirrups until another day. We suggest using a 20 x 40 meter arena or larger if possible.
- Be sure cones are set appropriately to be viewed.
- Film video in LANDSCAPE orientation.
- The natural background sound for the test should be audible.
- Video links must be created on YouTube. Video setting be set to Unlisted or Public. You may share your video on our Facebook Group!
- No Coaching allowed during the videoing of the pattern- you must have your pattern memorized.
- Videos of tests must be unedited from start to finish. They must be one continuous recording with the horse and rider visible at all times. Record from view before cone A or after E.
- You will enter your video link on the log submission page anytime from November 28th - December 4th.
